# Some aspects of information in the Brazilian indicator Trading across borders

Washington, March 28th and 29th, 2018

### Imports of auto parts from Argentina

Imports of auto parts from Argentina use mainly land border instead of the Port of Santos, considered by the Doing Business Report.



#### **Border compliance**

The procedures for compliance with the border requirements, contemplated by the Doing Business Report for importing auto parts, include "technical inspection by Ministry of Industry, Foreign Trade and Services – MDIC/wording of technical certificate".

Official Letter 1/2018-SEI-CGF/DECOE/SECEX, of the Ministry of Industry, Foreign Trade and Services – MDIC, regarding the inexistence of such procedure.

#### **Border compliance**

There was no change in the costs in compliance with the border requirements and the documentation in Reports from 2016 to 2018, despite appreciation of 28% of the Dollar against the Real during the period.


#### **Border compliance**

The mentioned procedure referred to "border compliance" includes exactly the same amount for total costs of the port/land border procedures, USD 504, both for importing auto parts and for exporting soybean and other grains, although logistics is significantly different for the products above mentioned.




